2. Public Comment:

a. Annie Sabel introduced herself to the committee and expressed her interest in being considered for the vacant tourism seat on committee.

3. Approval of Minutes:

a. Approval of minutes from June 16, 2020.

4. Work Session Items:

a. LS Network Broadband Presentation

- Jeff Houston gave an overview of the broadband company.
- Technical difficulty resulted and he was unable to share his computer to show the network of fiber throughout the Southern Oregon Region.

b. Recommendation for future Board Members for an Independent Non-Profit DMO

- Chair Merrill gave an overview of the last meeting where Jon Bowen spoke of an independent entity that would manage both tourism and economic development for the City and County.
- Discussion followed regarding the process that the City was embarking.

- Councilor Miles thought it would be beneficial to hire a consultant to facilitate the action and formulation of a non-profit board.
- Committee wanted more information of this proposed non-profit.
- Discussion followed regarding expansion of the whole County for the proposed non-profit board and Destination Management.
- Commissioner Fowler shared that currently it is city centric, however, the County would like to be considered.
- Member Molloy brought up the possibility of the chamber model.
- Councilor Roler thought it was a complicated process to develop a new structure.
- Member Androy did not agree that it was productive to add another board such as the one recommended.
- Chair Merrill reiterated that it was important for the committee to weigh in.
- Lora Glover explained more of a background of why this item was on the agenda to get input from the committee on who the influencers in the community would be beneficial to serve on the board.
- Steven Sabel gave the committee a recap of what staff has been doing in the absence of a DMO.
- Sabel went on to explain the proposed composition of what this board would look like as a founding board to hire a Director for the Tourism Board.
- Discussion followed about funding for tourism and how it is dispersed.
- Councilor Miles questioned if all of Josephine County would be included or just Grants Pass.
- It was mentioned that a unified committee/board would help navigate all of the events and activities that go on throughout the County.
- Member Engel brought up that as well as tourism, workforce housing would help the industry and businesses.
- Member Martin brought up that the process that the City is going through is cyclical.
- More discussion followed about funding for tourism and what is the best model to recommend.
