

RESOLUTION NO. 17-6578

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANTS PASS AMENDING THE CITY'S 2015-2019 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND ADOPTING THE 2017-2018 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE CDBG PROGRAM.

WHEREAS:

1. The City of Grants Pass (City) is identified as the principal city of a Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) following the 2010 Census; and
2. As the principal city of an MSA, the City was invited by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) as an entitlement grantee; and
3. Entitlement status enables the City to receive a direct allocation of CDBG funds and to work directly with HUD and community stakeholders on crafting a community development program that is responsive to local needs; and
4. As an entitlement community and direct recipient of CDBG funds, the City is required by federal law to follow its Citizen Participation Plan for adoption and major amendments to its 5-year Consolidated Plan and 1-Year Action Plans to identify needs, goals, and activities for use of CDBG funds consistent with federal guidelines; and
5. The City has followed its Citizen Participation Plan and developed an amended 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan and a new 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan, which address community needs, set goals, and identify activities for use of CDBG funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Grants Pass that the amended 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan attached hereto as Exhibit 'A' and the 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan attached hereto as Exhibit 'B' are adopted.


EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
