<p>2. Red Maple <i>Broadly oval, fast grower in our climate; Red flowers in spring with deep red to orange-red fall color Height: 50' Spread: 40'</i></p>		
<p>3. Japanese Zelkova <i>Vase shaped symmetrical crown, a tough urban tree; older trees bark exfoliates into small reddish-brown patches; fall color; Full sun Height: 50-80' Spread: 50-75'</i></p>		
<p>4. Flowering Pear <i>Narrow growth tree with shiny dark green leaves that turn orange to red purple in fall; Fragrant white flowers in spring; small non-edible fruits in summer; Full sun Height: 30-50' Spread: 15-25'</i></p>

<p>5. Willow Oak <i>Symmetrical pyramid to round crown shape, a handsome oak with narrow willow-like leaves; Yellow bronze-orange fall color, small acorns; Full sun Height: 60-70' Spread: 30-40'</i></p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Willow Oak <small>Quercus phellos</small></p>		
<p>6. Flowering Dogwood <i>Rounded growth form with showy flowers in spring, glossy red fruit in fall; Great red-purple fall color Height 25' Spread: 25'</i></p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Flowering Dogwood <small>Cornus florida</small></p>
