

CITY OF GRANTS PASS REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TESTING OF SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL BACKFLOW ASSEMBLIES



The City of Grants Pass is accepting bid proposals to perform testing services for approximately 4,610 single family residential backflow assemblies. The selected provider will be required to enter into a Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with the City.

A detailed listing of backflow assemblies will be provided to the contractor, including assembly address, general location, make, model, serial number, and size. Any missing information is the testing contractor's responsibility to document. There are approximately 850 reduced pressure principal backflow assemblies (RPBAs), 3,710 double check valve assemblies (DCVAs) and 50 pressure vacuum breaker assemblies (PVBAs) currently in the system.

Contractor shall secure and maintain in good standing through the life of the agreement:

- State of Oregon Backflow Assembly Tester Certification and OHA licensing
- City of Grants Pass Business License
- City of Grants Pass Prequalification
- Valid Oregon Driver's License
- Either be licensed as a construction contractor with the Construction Contractors Board as provided under ORS chapter 701; or be employed by a landscape contracting business licensed under ORS 671.760 as required by ORS~448.279.
- Proper vehicle identification as stated by the CCB
- Insurance and bonding for the life of the Contract
