Bidders on the above-named project are hereby notified that the Bidding Documents are modified as indicated below. Bidders are required to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Document 00410 Bid Form.

This Addendum shall become part of the Contract and provisions of the Contract apply.

SPECIFICATIONS

The following sections are modified as indicated below.

1. SECTION 00410 – Bid Form:
 - a. Edits to lump sum bid item table language:
 - 1) REPLACE section in its entirety with the attached section.
2. SECTION 01140 – Work Restrictions:
 - a. Replace references to “primary sludge” dewatering system to “primary and waste activated sludge” dewatering system:
 - 1) REPLACE paragraph 1.05 E.2 mention of “primary” with, “primary and waste activated sludge”.
 - 2) REPLACE paragraph 1.05 E.2.a mention of “primary” with, “primary and waste activated sludge”.
 - 3) REPLACE paragraph 1.05 E.2.b mention of “primary” with, “primary and waste activated sludge”.
3. SECTION 01230 – Alternates:
 - a. Temporary odor control piping and valves to be associated with each Alternate (C and D):
 - 1) REPLACE paragraph 1.03 C.2 in its entirety with the following:

Alternate: Installation of temporary enclosure for Owner’s sludge storage tank to allow its use as “temporary” storage in lieu of contractor-provided temporary sludge storage tanks. This Work includes a temporary enclosure for the tank, **temporary** odor control **piping/valving** of the sludge storage tank head space, temporary piping to/from sludge storage tank as shown on Contract Drawings, and all associated installation and removal labor for the temporary components installed.
 - 2) REPLACE paragraph 1.03 D.2 in its entirety with the following:

Alternate: Installation of temporary sludge storage tanks, mixers, temporary piping and valves as described in the Contract Documents to store a mixture of waste activated and primary sludge. This Work includes temporary storage tanks, **temporary** odor control **piping/valving** for the tanks, valving to provide tank isolation, and temporary piping to/from sludge storage tank as shown on Contract Drawings, and all associated installation and removal labor for the temporary components installed.

4. SECTION 11381 – Digester Appurtenances:
 - a. Include Groth for safety selector valve Manufacturers' list:
 - 1) ADD paragraph 2.06 A.2.a.3 that reads, "Groth, Model 8800SDV 3-way safety selector valve."
5. SECTION 11382 – Sludge Heat Exchangers:
 - a. Include JDV Equipment Corporation in Manufacturers' list:
 - 1) ADD paragraph 2.01 C.5 that reads, "JDV Equipment Corporation."
 - b. Replace moisture content description of digester gas to correctly say relative humidity:
 - 1) REPLACE paragraph 2.04 E.1.g with the following, "Moisture content: 90 percent relative humidity."

ARTICLE 4 — TIME OF COMPLETION

- 4.01 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially complete and will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the Document 00700 - General Conditions on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.
- 4.02 Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages.

ARTICLE 5 — BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: ACCEPTANCE PERIOD, INSTRUCTIONS, AND RECEIPT OF ADDENDA

- 5.01 Bid acceptance period:
 - A. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.
- 5.02 Instructions to Bidders:
 - A. Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security.
- 5.03 Receipt of Addenda:

ARTICLE 6 — BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

- 6.01 Bidder’s Representations:
 - A. In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents the following:
 - 1. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, including Addenda.
 - 2. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 3. Bidder is familiar with all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - 4. Bidder has carefully studied the reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and the drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Document 00800 - Supplementary Conditions, with respect to the Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
 - 5. Bidder has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the 00800 - Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

6. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Technical Data identified in the Document 00800 - Supplementary Conditions or by definition, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and Technical Data on (a) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (b) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, if selected as Contractor; and (c) Bidder's (Contractor's) safety precautions and programs.
7. Based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, Bidder agrees that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract.
8. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
9. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and of discrepancies between Site conditions and the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
10. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
11. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

6.02 Bidder's Certifications:

- A. The Bidder certifies the following:
 1. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation.
 2. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid.
 3. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding.
 4. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract as defined below:
 - a. Corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process.
 - b. Fraudulent practice means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition.
 - c. Collusive practice means a scheme or arrangement between 2 or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels.

- d. Coercive practice means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.
5. The undersigned as Bidder is registered with the Oregon Construction Contractors' Board as required by Oregon ORS, Section 701.026.
6. The undersigned as Bidder is licensed by the State Landscape Contractors' Board as required by Oregon ORS, Section 671.530.
7. The undersigned as Bidder is a Resident Bidder in the state of Oregon as defined in Oregon ORS, Section 279A.120.
8. Bidder shall comply with Oregon ORS, Section 279C.838, with respect to the payment of prevailing wages.
9. In accordance with Oregon ORS, Section 279A.120, Bidder shall state whether or not Bidder is a resident Bidder.
10. In accordance with Oregon ORS, Section 279C.840, Bidder shall comply with payment of prevailing wages.
