## STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING \*

The focus of the Solid Waste Agency in FY23 will be to continue the monitoring and remediation of the closed Kerby Landfill, monitoring of the closed Marlsan Landfill, elimination of household hazardous materials from the waste stream, clean up and elimination of solid waste contamination within Josephine County, and the promotion of community wide recycling efforts. The agency will also explore partnerships with Josephine County, BLM and USFS to create a patrol and investigation unit to detect and eliminate illicit dumping and the potential of adding a second free dump day for area residents.
