

## ADOPT-A-STREET

### HOW TO SIGN UP:

1. Locate a City street you would like to adopt.
2. Check with the Grants Pass City Public Works Dept. 541-450-6110 to see if your street is available for adoption.
3. Read the *Agreement and Terms* form located in the Public Works Dept., or available for download on the Grants Pass City website: [www.grantspassoregon.gov/1002](http://www.grantspassoregon.gov/1002). Turn in the filled out form to Public Works (located at the City Municipal Building Room 105)
4. If you are head of a group, each member will need to sign the *Liability Release* form.
5. After you are approved, you will need to sign the *Safety Guidelines*. Then pick up your vests and trash bags and you are set to start. That's it!!

NOTE: Each adoption is reviewed on a case by case basis for approval. Minors under 11 may participate but need adult supervision.

## About the program

The City of Grants Pass is encouraging local businesses, civic groups, youth organizations, academic institutions, families, and individuals to keep our community walkways clean and beautiful by participating in the Adopt-A-Street Program. The Adopt-A-Street Program is a great way to give back to your community and enjoy the benefits of a cleaner Grants Pass.

This Public Works Program promotes community pride by demonstrating to residents, tourists, and potential businesses that the community is active, energetic and cares about a clean and safe environment. It helps promote a cleaner, healthier Grants Pass.

Picking up refuse along our City streets will keep it out of the stormwater system and out of our creeks and rivers ensuring our waterways are healthy and attractive.



Adopt-A-Street members participate in cleanup efforts on their adopted street at least quarterly (four times a year).

Cleanups are scheduled by each group or individual participating and are done at your convenience. In exchange for a two-year commitment of litter pickup, a customized sign will be installed at each end of your adopted street to announce the name of your group and to honor your community spirit and service.

The City of Grants Pass will supply safety vests, trash bags and safety guidelines for the participants.
