Details:

The Grants Pass Department of Public Safety is still investigating the shooting incident that occurred on Tuesday, January 3rd, 2017 at 10:34AM. There were multiple reports of prior Reckless Driving acts committed by the arrestee, Robert Kujawski. The Grants Pass Department of Public Safety is requesting the public's assistance in identifying the driver, and a possible passenger, of a vehicle that may have been victimized.

The incident occurred on Friday, December 23rd, 2016 at 1:15 PM in the parking lot of Walmart. The victim vehicle is a blue 2-door vehicle that was making abrupt stops, or 'Break Checking' near the Taco Bell entrance at Walmart. The vehicle dropped off a female (Pictured below), who entered Walmart and purchased items inside. The female exited Walmart, got into the passenger side of the vehicle, and the 'Brake Checking' incident occurred as the vehicle drove through the parking lot to exit.

Investigators are looking to identify the female pictured below as a witness to the incident. Investigators are also looking to identify and speak to the driver of the blue vehicle as a witness as well. Anyone with any information is urged to contact Detective Ryan Brown at 541-450-6260.
