**Narrative:** On 1/26/17 at 1902 hours, Grants Pass DPS Police units responded to Fred Meyer after a tip of a 2010 Lexus SUV, stolen out of Medford being at the location. As Police units arrived, the Lexus fled at a high rate of speed and crashed into a 1999 Chevy Blazer on the GP Parkway after exiting the parking lot. The Lexus continued out of control and landed in the parking lot of the Parkway Christian Center, disabling it.

Witnesses reported a male and female fled from the stolen Lexus on foot. Police units established a perimeter and determined one of the fleeing subjects was wanted fugitive, Jordan Card from evidence located in the Lexus. Card has been linked to numerous stolen vehicles and has been associated with illegal drug activities. She has been involved in numerous vehicle eludes with law enforcement in both Josephine and Jackson Counties.

Police set up a perimeter in the area which led to the apprehension of Card as she attempted to get away by means of a private citizen where she was arrested. The fleeing male was not located. Detectives responded to assume the investigation. Card was lodged on her 7 felony warrants with additional charges to follow. There appears to be no serious injuries from the crash.
